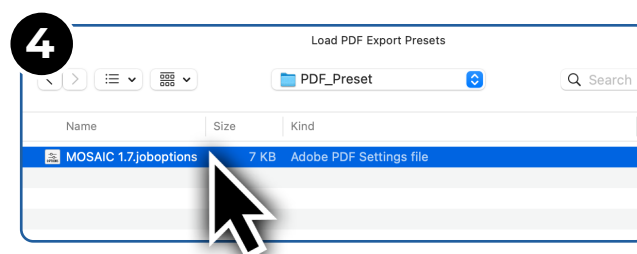
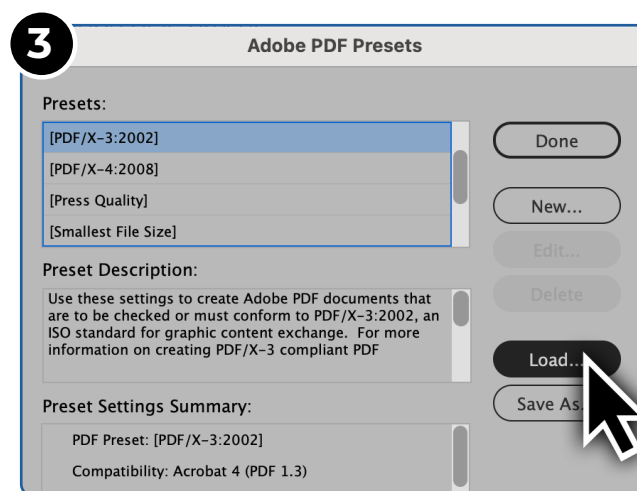
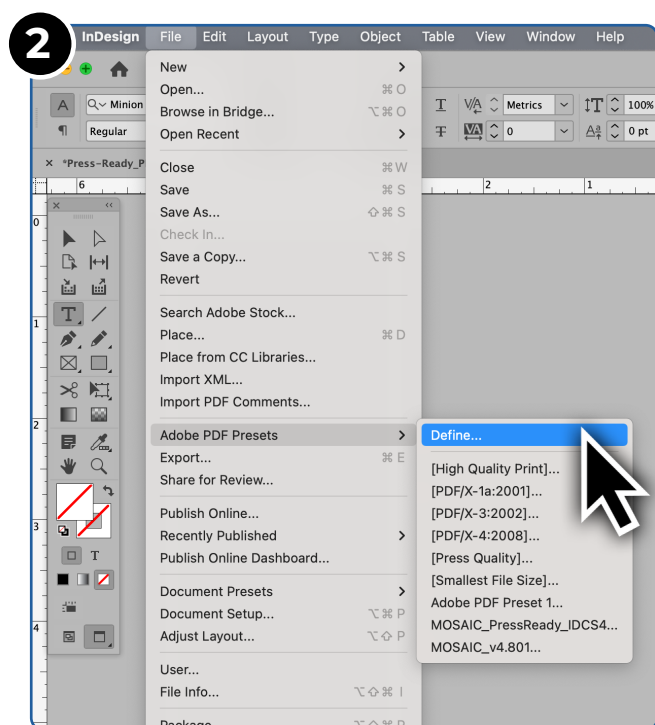
Downloading and importing MOSAIC's latest PDF preset

1. [Click this link to download MOSAIC's latest Adobe PDF preset.](#)

a. Upon download, a file named **Mosaic 1.7.2.joboptions** should be in your Downloads folder in a folder called **PDF_Preset**. You may need to uncompress the file.

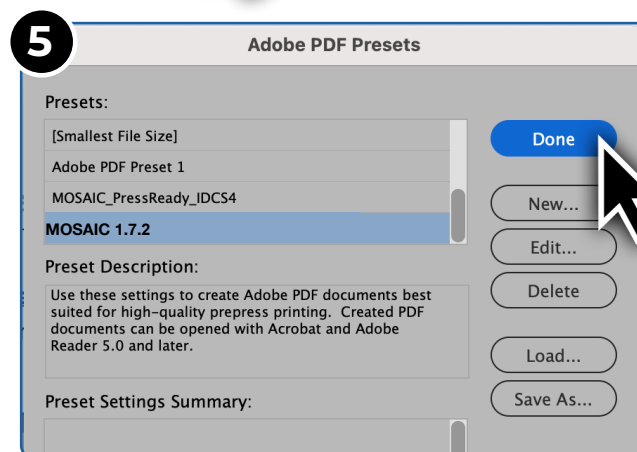
2. In InDesign, Go to File > Adobe PDF Presets > **Define**

3. Click **LOAD**.



4. After clicking **LOAD**, find the Preset file that was downloaded and click **OPEN**.

5. Click **DONE**. The MOSAIC press-ready preset file has now been loaded, and can now be chosen when you need to export a MOSAIC press-ready PDF file.





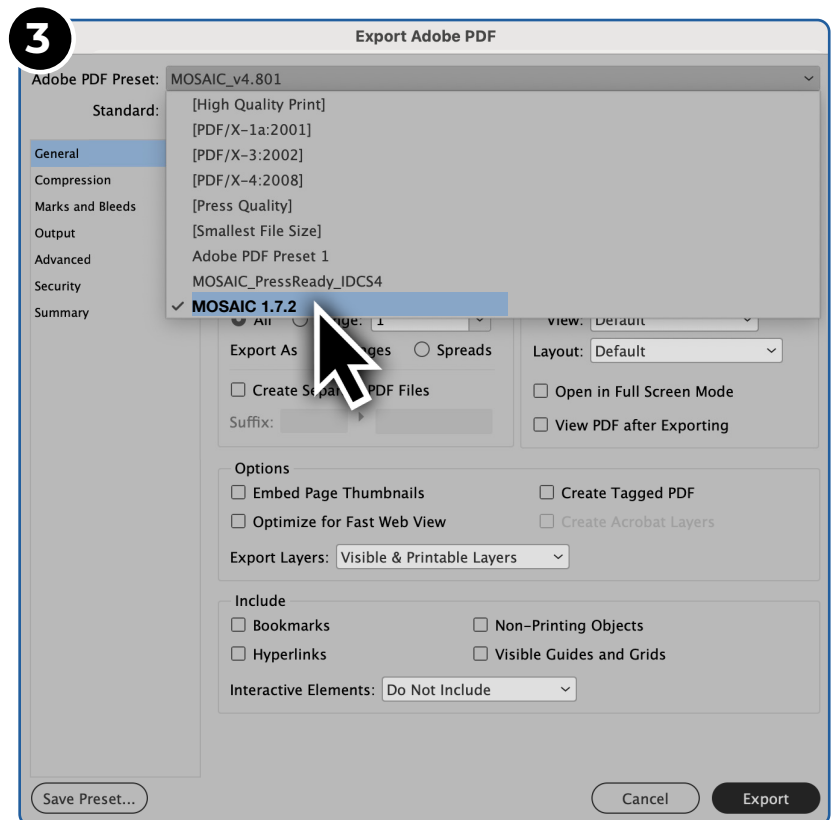
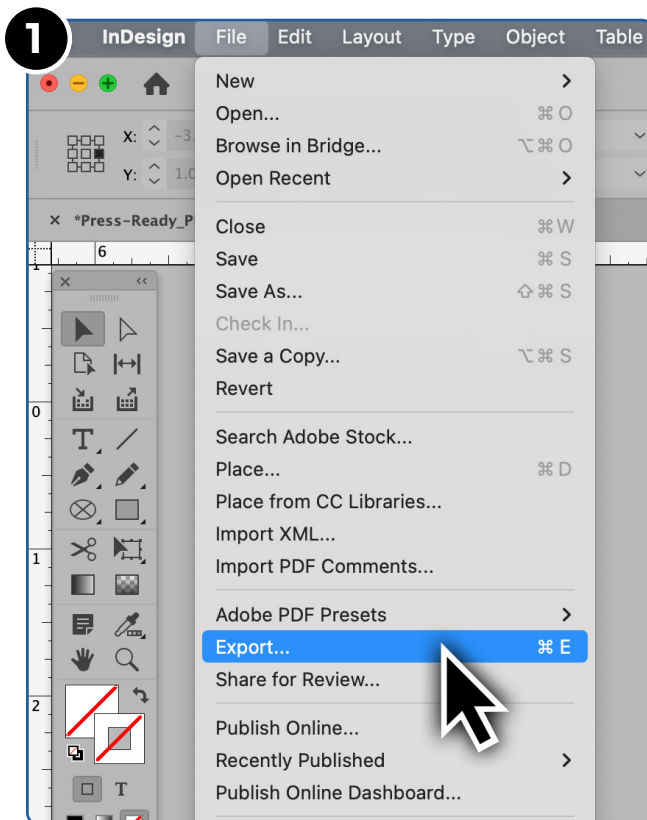

Exporting a press-ready PDF file for MOSAIC

Notes for prepping files before PDF export:

- Delete all unused colors
- No duplicate colors
- Colors named correctly
- All colors CMYK or SPOT
- All bleeds at 1/8" (.125")

1. In InDesign, Go to File > **Export**
2. Designate where you would like to save the file.
3. Choose the preset file that you imported.



4. Click **EXPORT** and your presss-ready PDF will be saved and ready to be uploaded to MOSAIC!
